



Happy Home Pack

A happy home pack is provided to clients who are newly housed. Most clients who receive a happy home pack were previously homeless or living in an unsafe home environment. Since men and women receive happy home packs, we try to provide items that are neutral in color (tans, greens, and blues). Our goal is to have 20 happy home packs available for distribution each year. Currently no funding is available for these items and our ability to provide this service to clients rests entirely on donations. Because these clients often have very little, we try to provide clients with new items that are free of defects for a fresh start in their new place.

Items for a complete Happy Home Pack include the following items:

- Bath Towels (2)
- Kitchen Towels (2)
- Drinking cups (2)
- Coffee cup (1)
- Bowls (2)
- Plates (2)
- Silverware (2 sets)
- Dish soap
- Dish brush or dish cloth (no sponges)
- Cooking pot (medium or large)
- Plastic spoon for cooking (1)
- Plastic spatula for cooking (1)
- Larger cutting knife for food preparation (1)
- Plastic containers to hold leftovers (2)
- One large plastic storage container with lid to hold "happy home" items
