

Do you have a utility shut-off notice?

Did you lose your job or get unexpected bills and can't afford to pay next month's rent?

Are you sleeping on someone's couch because you can't afford the deposit for your own place?



## You may qualify for rent or utility assistance through the Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA) Program at Tulsa CARES

### Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ You must be HIV-positive or have a household member who is HIV-positive
- ✓ Your monthly bills must be more than your monthly income
- ✓ For rental or utility assistance, your name must be on the lease
- ✓ You live in one of these counties: Ottawa, Delaware, Cherokee, Adair, Sequoyah, LeFlore, Latimer, Haskell, Pittsburg, McIntosh, Okfuskee, Muskogee, Mayes, Washington, Nowata, Craig.
- ✓ **To access the program, ask your primary care coordinator for a referral**
- ✓ Your income must be less than 80% of the Area Median Income (see table below)
